PHRN is a vibrant, active organization - now in its twelfth year - with a proud record of building resident involvement in the preservation and improvement of publicly-assisted housing for our state's low income residents. PHRN is committed to the intensive work of true resident empowerment - knocking on doors, having conversations at the kitchen table, bringing neighbors together, developing resident leadership, teaching the skills of civic engagement, and providing education about housing policy and revitalization practices, and the building of a strong democratic organization.

The PHRN Board meets once a month. Statewide membership meetings are held every March, June, September, and December.

Through PHRN, publicly-assisted housing residents and their allies are fighting to preserve and improve publicly-assisted housing as a vital housing resource for low income families.
